General Information:

Google maps is an excellent resource for finding restaurants and food options. The Google restaurant ratings are usually a reasonably good indicator of the food quality and popularity of the restaurant.

Old Town Fort Collins is centered around the intersection of College Ave and Mountain Ave, about 1.2 miles northeast of the CSU Lory Student Center. It is a generally safe and easy walk from the CSU campus. Lots of restaurants and shopping options in this area with a number of food options listed below. Most of the restaurants have websites that will list menus and prices. Some offer reservations either via a phone call or via various on-line services. Reservations for the nicer restaurants are recommended on weekends when they are the busiest.

Prices: reasonable, moderate, and expensive.

Restaurant Recommendations:

Los Tarascos (622 S College Ave, Fort Collins, CO): This is a Mexican style restaurant that is the closest to campus and an excellent dinner option. Somewhat limited parking, so best to walk to. My wife thinks this is the best Mexican restaurant in the area. Price: moderate. Closed on Monday. Open 11 AM to 9 PM (10 PM on Friday & Saturday) other days.

Choice City Butcher & Deli (104 W Olive St, Fort Collins, CO): Sandwich shop with a long history in Fort Collins. Lunch or light dinner sandwich/deli options. Price: reasonable.
